Microbiology, & BSc Medical Biochemistry Courses in AKG Co- Operative Institute of Health Sciences (AKGCIHS) against the sanctioned intake for the academic year 2022-23.

B.P.T. (Bachelor of Physiotherapy)

Duration : 4¹/₂ Years

Number of seats : 50

Eligibility for admission

- ☛ Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary education, Kerala or examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Science with **50% Marks in Biology separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together** with usual relaxation of mark for Scheduled Castes\Scheduled Tribes and SEBC students as fixed by Government of Kerala.

B.Sc. Medical Lab Technology (BSc.MLT)

Duration : 4 Years

Number of seats : 30

Eligibility for admission

- ☛ Candidates for admission to the course shall have passed the Higher secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or courses recognized equivalent there to by the Kerala University of Health Sciences with **50% marks in Science subjects Group II in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and**

English put together with usual relaxation allowed by Government of Kerala for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and SEBC candidates.

B.Sc. Optometry

Duration : 4 Years

Number of seats : 30

- ☛ Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Government of Kerala or examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with **50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together**, are eligible. Usual relaxation allowed by Government of Kerala for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and SEBC candidates

BSc Medical Micro Biology

Duration : 4 Years

Number of seats : 24

- ☛ Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary education, Kerala or examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Science with **50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.**
- ☛ Usual relaxation allowed by Government of Kerala for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and SEBC candidates

BSc Medical Biochemistry

Duration : 4 Years

Number of seats : 24

- ☛ Candidates for admission to the course shall have passed the Higher secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or courses recognized equivalent there to by the Kerala University of Health Sciences with **50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.**
- ☛ Usual relaxation allowed by Government of Kerala for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and SEBC candidates

Note:-

1. Rules of reservation prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences will be strictly followed for admissions.
2. The student should have 17 years of age as on 31st December of the admission year

III. ADMISSION

1. Admission to the Courses will be on the basis of merit.
 2. Allotment to 50% of the total seats will be made by the **Government**, and 50% of the remaining seats come under '**Management quota**'.
- Management Seats: - Management seats are those seats set apart for the eligible candidates selected from the applications received against the notification by the management directly based on the merit in qualifying exam and interview.

V. HOW TO APPLY

All candidates seeking admission to the Paramedical Degree courses, under Management Quota must apply only online in the website www.akgcihs.com from **29-07-2022**. Last date for submitting online application is **25-08-2022**. Candidates should register only one application for admission to Paramedical Degree courses. During the submission of online application, candidates have to enter the marks obtained by them in the subjects concerned in their Qualifying Examination, in the website.

1. Application Fee : Rs. 650/-

2. Mode of Payment: Online

Note: The Application fee/additional fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

The above mentioned documents must be uploaded along with the application for completion of your registration in the website.

There is no need to send the hard copy of the application to institute by hand or through post.

VI. SELECTION AND ADMISSION

1. Selection of the candidates for management quota will be done among the candidates who have only successfully applied in the college website, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination under rank list put up by the management.
2. The Selected candidates will be informed via mobile calls and mail regarding the date and time of their interview for the admission into the course.

3. The candidates must compulsorily produce the following documents in original at the time of their interview to the admission.
 - Hard copy of the application form
 - S.S.L.C.
 - Plus two mark list
 - 5 Passport size photograph (included 1 stamp size)
 - Transfer certificate
 - Course and Conduct Certificate issued by the head of educational institution last attended.
4. The fact that candidates have been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection into the course.
5. If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.
6. The Institute will not be responsible if the selected candidate has given an invalid contact number or mail and also if the selected candidate does not respond to the interview calls and mail.

VII. DEALING WITH FRAUDULENT INFORMATION

Admission to the Courses is purely provisional and if any fraud is detected at any stage in the mark list or certificate produced by the candidate, his/her admission will automatically be cancelled and he/she will be removed from the rolls and appropriate legal procedure will be initiated by the Institution against such candidates.

Use of mobile phones

- ☛ Usage of Mobile phones by the students are strictly prohibited in the college/hospital campus. Any violation of the prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college management.

- ☛ All the students who are selected should obey the rules and regulations of the institution without fail.

VIII. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

(a) Ragging
